What You Do

Cut out the strips on the dotted line and then allow your child to color and decorate the pages. Staple the pages together once complete.

WhatYouSay

"Today we learned all about ways we can help others. Do you know what a coupon is? A coupon is a piece of paper that you can use to get something for free. So, we're going to make a coupon book to give to someone."

"Use the crayons and stickers to decorate these papers. *(Pause)* They look great! Now, let's stack these coupons with the cover on top and staple them together. Now you can give your coupon book to anyone you want to help."
